

The description of the Social Chair's responsibilities in the MBAA Constitution states that:

The Social Chair shall

- a) Organize and be responsible for all social activities of the Association, and make certain that when funds of the Association are involved, all members are invited to the activity.
- b) Purchase items and materials as needed for the activity, in cooperation with the Treasurer.
- c) Coordinate social activities with any recruiters or faculty members who may be sponsoring or interested in attending the events.
- d) Administer the sign up and dispersion of football tickets.
- e) Strive to meet the objectives of the MBAA as stated in Article II, Section 1 of the MBAA Constitution.

House Chair- responsible for securing house locations for informal events

Tailgate Chair- responsible for organizing Saturday's tailgate spot

**Event T-shirts** Designs created in advance and submitted and then any MBA student can order an event t-shirt through grafcow.com
